—The School of Computer Science has announced its Siebel Scholars for 2004: **Aditya Agarwal, Nikhil Bansal, Jun Gao, Nicholas Hopper,** and **Aleksandar Nanevski**. The Siebel Scholars program was established at Carnegie Mellon and 10 other schools in the U.S. Carnegie Mellon received a \$2.5 million gift to recognize students who have distinguished themselves through academic and leadership excellence. Each Siebel Scholar award is \$25,000; the student receives \$2,500 and his/her unit receives \$22,500 to help pay educational costs (tuition, stipend, fees, etc.).
